

**DIRECTIONS TO ESSA (ENFIELD SCOUT SAILING ASSOCIATION)
Central Lagoon, Meadgate Road, Nazeing, Essex EN9 2PB**

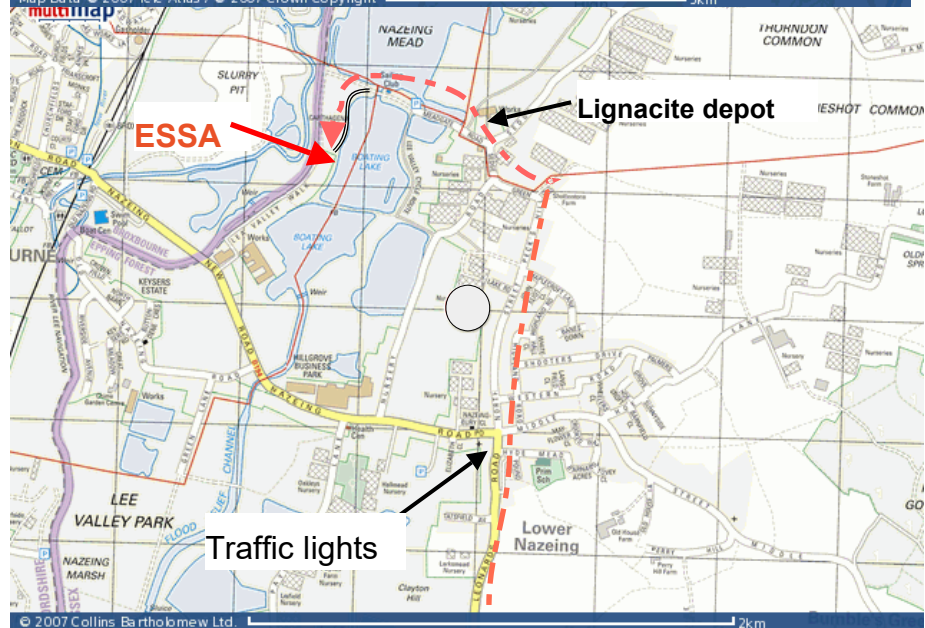
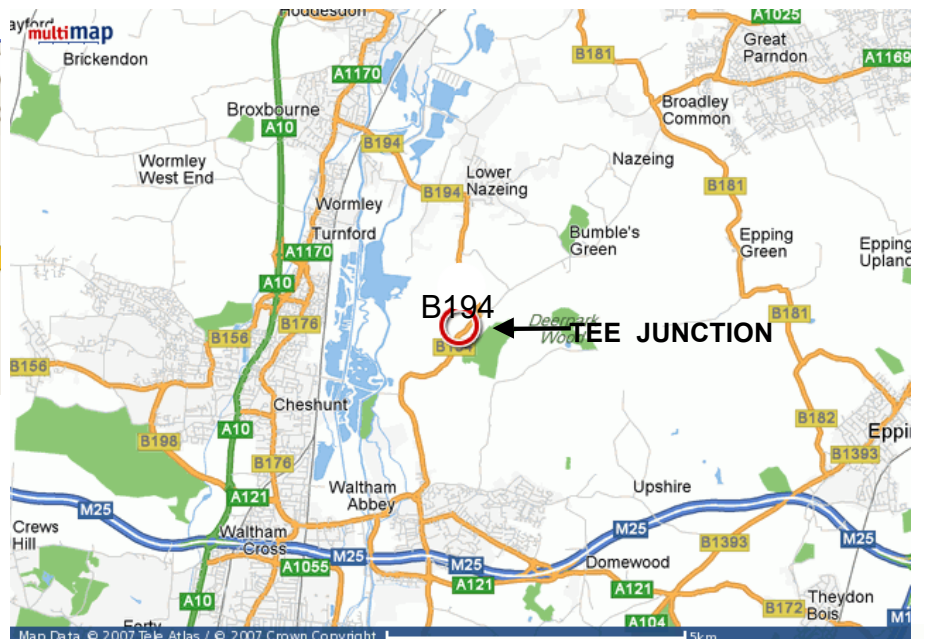
Travel to Waltham Abbey via Epping New Road (A104) to Wake Arms take left exit towards M25 and follow A121 to roundabout with A112. (Alternatively via Chingford and Bury Road to Sewardstone Road A112).

At the roundabout take 3rd exit onto A112 past Tescos and straight through 2 sets of traffic lights.

At the next roundabout, take the **3rd** exit onto **B194/Crooked Mile towards Harlow and Nazeing**. Continue to follow B194. At Tee Junction, turn **left** onto **B194/St Leonards Rd towards Nazeing**, follow B194 to the traffic lights. Go Straight across the traffic lights into North St. And up a hill, this becomes **Peck's Hill** past G & W Fencing company (with windmill) sharp bend left (**Peck's Hill** becomes **Sedge Green**) then sharp right.

When you see a sign for **"Lignacite works"** on left after a right hand bend, turn left here onto **Meadgate Road**. There should be a sign up for **Broxbourne Sailing Club**.

This is extremely bumpy but keep going past the lake and boats on your **RIGHT** and Broxbourne Sailing Club buildings. Once you've passed over the bridge/weir, immediately after this, **turn left** down a small track. (Be careful that you don't miss this left turn and end up in the River Lea(!)). The track will lead you alongside the Central Lagoon on your left and you will reach a small car park at the end. The gates and building in front of you is ESSA.
